## Minutes of Meeting 02/22 of Yapham cum Meltonby Parish Council on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2022 in Yapham Village Hall

**17/22** Present: Cllr Arnold, Cllr Bradley (in the chair), Cllr Gray, Cllr Hammond, Cllr Moverley, clerk. Apologies were received from Cllr Jefferson-Hallett and Cllr Newman. Cllr Bradley welcomed everyone to the meeting.

## **18/22 Code of Conduct**

- a) Declarations of Interest: Cllr Hammond declared his abstention from voting on planning items due to his position as ERYC Chair of Planning Committee.
- b) Granting of any dispensations: None

**19/22 Period of Public Participation:** No members of the public were present.

**20/22 Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2022:** These were adopted as a true record – Proposed by Cllr Gray and seconded by Cllr Moverley.

**21/22 Matters arising:** None.

**22/22 Planning:** Planning Consultation for 21/04713/CLE/ Certificate of Lawfulness for existing use of former office/storage building as a dwellinghouse / Land East of Yapham Grange Keldspring Lane Yapham Mill YO42 1PS/ Mr Pemberton: Cert of Lawful Development – Existing: **Agreed: Council is willing to support the application with a recommendation that the dwelling remains legally attached to the existing business and cannot be sold as a separate entity. ACTION – Submit comment to ERYC Planning Portal (Clerk).**

ACTION: Finalise details and order plaque (s) – (Cllr Arnold & Clerk).

**26/22 Bench and Plaque for Meltonby** - The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Community Fund 2022. **Agreed:** A bench is the ideal commemorative item. Plating a tree either side would also salute the Queens Green Canopy project. Clerk to continue with application to access the grant and secure as much funding as possible. Cllr Hammond will contact Highways to request a site visit. ACTION – Clerk & Cllr Hammond.

**27/22 Project Planning for 2022/23:** All ongoing as agreed.

**28/22 Councillors reports: Clir Arnold** has noted regular speeding coming into Yapham from the Pocklington direction. He is concerned about the dangers to cyclists, pedestrians and oncoming vehicles. He urges drivers to show respect and remember the speed limits are in place for a good reason.

**Clir Hammond** has reported an increase of dog fouling between Yapham Mill and the junction with the cricket club. The Dog Warden has increased signage and will to respond appropriately to further offences.
