35/23 Present: Cllr Arnold, Cllr Bradley (Chair), Cllr L Hammond Cllr M Hammond, Cllr Gray, and the clerk. Apologies were received from Cllr Newman. Two members of the public (MoP).

36/23 Code of Conduct

- a) Declarations of Interest: Cllr Hammond declared his abstention from voting on planning items, due to his position as ERYC Chair of Planning Committee, along with a pecuniary interest in Finance Item 41/23 b reimbursement.

- **37/23 Public Participation:** Item 43/23 was brought forward for a member of the Village Hall Committee to participate and contribute. One MoP left the building immediately following this item.

VHC to check insurance for holding a barbeque. PC members thanked the VHC member for their input.
