# St Martin's Church, Yapham cum Meltonby in the Barmby Moor Group of Churches - Progress report

- A digital survey of the church building has now been completed providing an accurate measurement of every dimension of its structure. This will enable the architect to create a schedule of work and associated costs for stabilising and refurbishing the church building which in turn, will pave the way for submitting grant allocations to help fund the project. Suggestions of suitable grant-awarding bodies would be welcome. It is our strong desire to restore the church to its former glory.
- The Barmby Moor Group of Churches has created a vision for growth, and in September launched a threeyear strategic plan to translate this vison into reality.
- The cultural landscape, and rural village life in particular, has changed dramatically over the last fifty years, and the Church needs to adapt or it will quite simply die. We do not expect to fill our churches every Sunday because quite rightly, there are many other God-given blessings for folks to enjoy on a Sunday. However, we do believe we have a unique contribution that we can make to people's well-being and in connecting and enriching the soul of community life.
- Therefore, it is our hope and prayer that the churches seek to serve our communities so that the church in each village, in way that is different from the past, will become a vibrant and permanent part of the community hub.
- We believe our links with the Parish Council, the Village hall Committee and other groups and ventures and events that happen in Yapham and Meltonby are crucial in linking church and community in ways that celebrate and enrich our lives together in this beautiful part of the East Riding of Yorkshire.
