Minutes of Meeting on the 21st September 2021

Meeting 9/21

Present: Cllrs Bradley (Chairman), Arnold, Hammond, Newman, Moverley, Jefferson-Hallett and Gray. One Member of the Public (MoP).

95/21 Welcome and Apologies: The Meeting started at 19:30. The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting. The Clerk sent her apologies due to illness, it was therefore, agreed that Cllr Hammond would take the minutes, and act as clerk until she recovers.

96/21 Code of Conduct: No declarations were made.

97/21 Public Participation: It was agreed that the meeting be suspended to allow the MoP to address the Council.

The Chairman of the Gravel Pits allotment Association attended the meeting to advise the Council that from 1st December 2021, the association intendeds to make changes to its tenancy agreements.

It was agreed that the Council did not need to give permission for this as the landowner, and that it was entirely up to the association. However, the Council thanked the association for taking the time and thought to advise them of the changes.

98/21 Minutes of Previous Meeting: Due to the Clerks ill health, no minutes were available. Therefore, it was agreed to defer this to the next meeting when hopefully the Clerk will be better and they will be available.

99/21 Matters Arising: Cllr Hammond updated the Council that the paint for the phone box in Yapham has arrived and is in his possession. He will look to carry out the works as soon as possible. Cllr Newman volunteered to assist.

Cllr Arnold asked for an update on the Council's objection to the increased lorry license application made by ChemPlus Ltd to the Traffic Commissioner. It was agreed to ask the Clerk for an update on this when she is recovered.

100/21 Planning: Due to the Clerk's ill health, the Council did not have access to the relevant information about current planning applications or decision notices. It was agreed to ask Clerk for update when she is recovered.

101/21 Finance and Accounts: Agreed to defer till next meeting so to get relevant information from Clerk once she is recovered.

102/21 Parish Project and Grant Application: Cllr Hammond updated the Council on progress with this. The application is now complete, all that is needed is a bank statement, which

he will get from the Clerk once she is recovered and will then submit the application. The costing for the project has now been completed.

104/21 Councillors Reports:

Cllr Moverly provided a Neighbourhood Watch update.

Cllr Hammond informed the Council that Pocklington Police Station had now been reinstated as a full time Police Station, which is great news for our area.
