Minutes of a meeting of Yapham cum Meltonby Parish Council on 14th August 2018 in Yapham

Village hall at 7.30pm

Present: Cllr P Arnold, Cllr P Bradley (chairman), Cllr L Gray, Cllr L Hammond, Cllr K Moverley, Cllr R O'Gram

80/18 Welcome & Apologies: Clir Bradley welcomed everyone to the meeting.

81/18 Declarations of Interest. Clir Hammond declared a non-pecuniary interest in an item on benches in the clerk's report.

82/18 Public Participation. There were no members of the public wishing to speak.

83/18 The minutes of the meeting held on 10th July 2018 were proposed by Clir Moverley and seconded by Clir Gray and agreed as a true and accurate record and Clir Bradley signed them as such on behalf of the council.

84/18 To receive the clerk's report on matters being progressed from previous meetings.

**Benches**- the clerk had contacted ERYC Highways department to ask what permission was required regarding the siting of the benches, but had not yet had a reply.

Cllr Hammond had received 3 prices for benches.

It was agreed to initially look at providing a replacement bench for the one at Yapham, which was in a poor state of repair, and a replacement for the one at Yapham Mill, which was stolen some years ago. As the council had not budgeted for benches in the current year it would not be able to afford the full cost without using a significant part of the reserves.

The bench at Yapham had previously been funded by donations from the public. Cllr Hammond offered to ask residents for pledges towards the cost of the benches. It might also be possible to ask for funding from a local charity such as the Lions.

**Litter / Fly tipping**- the clerk had reported the waste materials down Feoffee Lane and the Environment agency had already been informed and it was expected to be removed in the near future.

Cllr Gray reported there was another site behind Alder Lodge on Feoffee Lane. This had been reported in 2017. It was agreed that the clerk should report this to ERYC.

Concern was expressed about how this grain store would stand out in the landscape, particularly on the approach down the hill. It was agreed to ask for a condition that trees should be planted to screen it. It was noted that a previous planning application for this site had required screening but the trees planted had failed.
